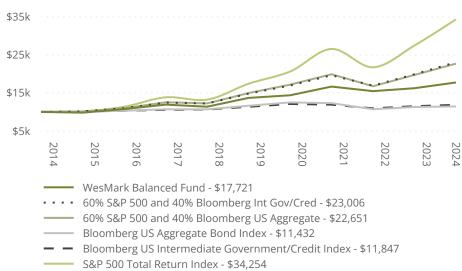
How did the Fund perform last year?

The WesMark Balanced Fund Fund returned 9.30% for the 12 months ended December 31, 2024. This is in contrast to the S&P 500 Total Return Index, which had a 25.02% return for the same time period. Please see below tables for additional indexes.

2024 proved an exceptional year for stocks, driven by economic growth, declining inflation, and the Artificial Intelligence boom, despite a late-year dip and the Federal Reserve signals of fewer 2025 rate cuts. Bond investors saw muted gains amid a volatile year influenced by Fed policy and persistent inflation. The fixed income allocation ended the year with a modified duration of 4.61 years and an average credit rating of A-, with minor allocation shifts across taxable municipal, securitized/US government, and corporate debt.

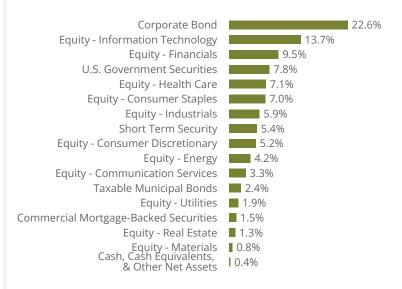
